

Belgian Business Federation Deplores VW Job Losses at Brussels Factory

RUSSELS (AFX) - The Federation of Enterprises in Belgium (FEB) said it 'deplored' the job losses resulting from Volkswagen AG's decision to halt production of its Golf model at its Brussels factory.

Management at the factory have decided to cut about 4,000 jobs, a Belgian union official said earlier today.

The FEB called on the parties involved to help those affected look for new jobs.

It added that the automobile industry remains an 'important economic sector' in Belgium and cannot be 'condemned'.
