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Notes to invoice above

1. Healy Consultants Group PLC's fees to efficiently and effectively complete Barbados company registration within <u>6 weeks</u> by <u>i)</u> choosing the optimum regulatory licence for our Client's business activities <u>ii)</u> reserving a company name with the <u>Corporate Affairs and Intellectual Property Office</u> <u>iii)</u> settling our accountant and lawyer fees and <u>iv)</u> preparing a high quality company incorporation application for the Barbados government.

All <u>engagement fees</u> are agreed and paid up front and agree to the fees published on our country web pages. Consequently, there are no hidden fees, surprises or ambushes throughout the engagement. All engagement deadlines are agreed up front in the form of a <u>detailed project plan</u>, mapping out <u>deliverables</u> by week throughout the engagement term.



Every week during the engagement, Healy Consultants Group PLC will email our Client a <u>detailed status update</u>. Our Client is immediately informed of engagement problems together with solutions. Your dedicated engagement manager is reachable by phone, Skype, live chat and email and will communicate in your preferred language.

Effective 1 January 2019, all companies operating in Barbados are required to fulfil <u>economic substance</u> requirements by i) being directed and managed in Barbados ii) conducting Core Income Generating Activities (CIGA) in Barbados and iii) having adequate people, premises and expenditure in Barbados.

2. In accordance with the <u>Barbados Companies Act Ch 308</u>, each Barbados LLC must appoint a company secretary, who may be a natural person or a body corporate, but the company secretary must be resident in Barbados. Healy Consultants Group PLC will act as your Barbados company secretary, for which our annual responsibilities include i) preparing and filing the legal annual return ii) securely maintaining company records iii) liaising with the Barbados government on our Client's behalf iv) legal filing of changes of company structure and v) reminding our Client of statutory deadlines.

In accordance with Barbados law, an LLC shall, as from the date of its incorporation, have a legal registered office in Barbados, to which all official government communications and notices may be addressed. To comply with this statutory requirement, Healy Consultants Group PLC will supply a Barbados shared office space as the registered office address for your company. Thereafter, this address will be used to receive government correspondence including i) tax letters ii) notice of the legal annual return and iii) all government communications. Most of our Clients wish to place Healy Consultants Group PLC's office address on invoices, contracts, websites and business cards.

3. This fee is an estimate of government costs payable during your Firm's engagement. For transparency purposes, all government fee payments will be supported by original receipts and invoices. Examples of government costs include i) paying name reservation fee at the <u>Corporate Affairs and Intellectual Property Office</u> and ii) registration payment with the <u>Payment Gateway</u>. Following engagement completion, Healy Consultants Group PLC will refund our Client any excess funds received over actual government costs paid;

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- 4. To secure multi-currency corporate bank account approvals for our Client's company, Healy Consultants Group PLC's strategy is as follows:
 - Healy Consultants Group PLC will prepare a quality business plan for our Client's review then use the same to i) secure multiple banks' confirmation they welcome a formal application from our Client's business and ii) maximise the probability of successful multi-currency corporate bank account approvals;
 - At the time of company incorporation, we recommend to keep the corporate structure simple by appointing our Client's preferred individual shareholder(s) and director(s) and bank signatories no corporate entity, nominee, trust, or tax haven holding company:
 - Our Client to appoint individuals who could timely travel to meet multiple local and international banks, if their Compliance Departments require the same before releasing multiple multi-currency corporate bank accounts numbers. If travel is required, our Firm will refund US\$950 and action this travel policy;
 - Before, during and after bank meetings, the bank's In-house Legal and Compliance Department may revert multiple times for additional documentation and information from each i) bank signatory / director / UBOs of the companies as well as ii) our Client's business and transactions;
 - ✓ If some banks decline to board our Client's business, Healy Consultants Group PLC will immediately inform our Client and action backup banking solutions;
 - ✓ All going well in an average of 3 months following application submission, Healy Consultants Group PLC secures multiple multi-currency corporate bank account numbers for our Client's company;
 - Thereafter, Healy Consultants Group PLC or the banks will courier mails and e-banking to the bank signatory, who is expected to activate the Internet bank account, if needed with Healy Consultants Group PLC's assistance;
 - ✓ Affter corporate bank account numbers are secured and if required, Healy Consultants Group PLC to assist our Client to appoint more new shareholders and directors. However, the banks will usually only approve them as bank signatory after a face to face meeting and review and approval of a bank signatory application;

For each bank, our Firm will prepare a quality tailored business plan, to optimise the probability of corporate bank account approval. Each corporate bank account opening fee is <u>US\$4,950</u>. It is a time-consuming task. Healy Consultants Group PLC will shelter our Client from the administrative challenges. As you can appreciate, it is a difficult task to obtain bank account approval through newly-formed companies when shareholders, directors and bank signatories reside overseas;

Depending on the nationality of the UBO, shareholders, bank signatories, and directors and the nature and value of the business assets and transactions, it is wise to expect that i) corporate bank account approvals will take an average of three months from the date of company registration and receipt of all KYC documentation and ii) multiple banks will request the directors AND bank signatories travel for a one hour interview with the bank officer, before bank account opening. Refer to the notes below for more detailed important information about each corporate bank account opening procedures and requirements.

While Healy Consultants Group PLC will be glad to assist our Client to open multiple corporate bank accounts, it is challenging and time consuming to open corporate bank accounts for businesses when their shareholders, directors and bank signatories do not live in the country where the bank account is being

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applied for. Consequently, it will take us an average of <u>twelve weeks</u> to open each corporate bank account, counting from receipt of all required KYC documentation. Healy Consultants Group PLC will prepare a business plan for the bank to optimise the probability of corporate bank account approval.

During the corporate bank account opening process, it is common for each bank's in-house Legal and Compliance Department to request additional <u>due diligence</u> documents from potential customers including but not limited to i) regulatory licenses ii) proof of business globally and in home country including evidence of contracts, invoices and agreements with local Clients and iii) additional KYC information on our Client's business and place of residency, including nature and volume of transactions. We assume our Client provides most of this information within one week.

Because global interest rates are low, international banks make little profit from current accounts. Consequently, international banks appetite for new multi-currency corporate bank account opening applications is low. Therefore, global banks are more likely to reject new multi-currency corporate bank account opening applications. Because of the above, customer demand for new corporate bank accounts is very high. As a result, international banks choose vanilla customers that tick all the boxes of a low risk Client. For example, most banks will only welcome multi-currency corporate bank account opening applications from a company registered in the same country, with local staff and office premises.

When dealing with international banks, the front office bank officer (Relationship Manager) is willing to help Healy Consultants Group PLC and our multi-national Clients. The realistic role of this bank officer is to collect information and ensure an accurate and complete multi-currency corporate bank account opening application is submitted to the bank in-house Legal and Compliance Department.

Unfortunately, the bank in-house Legal and Compliance Department has ultimate power of approval over new multi-currency corporate bank account applications. This Department is extremely risk adverse and often lacks commercial reality. Furthermore, the in-house Legal and Compliance Department does not speak to customers nor to Healy Consultants Group PLC. All communications must go through the front office bank officer. Consequently, quality Clients do not get a chance to communicate directly with the bank decision makers – a chance to properly explain their business and the risks the bank perceives.

Global banks enjoy ultimate power of approval of corporate bank account applications. Consequently, guaranteed success is outside of Healy Consultants Group PLC control. What is inside our control is the preparation and submission of a high quality bank application that maximizes the likelihood of approval.

Global banks <u>continue to tighten</u> corporate bank account opening procedures, their internal compliance departments completing more thorough due diligence of Clients. Consequently, our Client should expect the bank account approval period <u>at least</u> 2 months, and on average 3 months.

During the engagement, banks will revert to Healy Consultants Group PLC and our Client to request additional KYC information, including i) details of existing business setup ii) reason for opening bank accounts in the specific jurisdiction iii) list of suppliers and Clients in the jurisdiction iv) lease agreement and v) proof of net worth from the shareholders and evidence the same are complying with their local taxation reporting obligations. As always, Healy Consultants Group PLC will liaise with the bank to secure exemption from these requirements.

While Healy Consultants Group PLC will try its best to negotiate with the bank for a travel exemption unfortunately some banks may request both the foreign directors and bank signatories to travel, for a one-hour interview before the bank account numbers are issued. If the banks also request Healy Consultants Group PLC nominees to travel, there will be an additional fee of US\$5,950 per trip payable to cover the flight and hotel and other trip disbursements.

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All banking charges, certification and translation and other third-party fees incurred during the corporate bank account opening process are to be borne by our Client, never by the nominees. These additional fees are to be payable in advance of any disbursement.

Healy Consultants Group PLC will supply the banks with the proof of addresses and other due diligence supplied by our Client. Hopefully they will accept the same and do not revert requesting additional documents; From our side we will relentlessly negotiate for banks waivers. Healy Consultants Group PLC expects the bank's risk department to request additional due diligence from our Client's business and from the bank signatory, directors, shareholders and UBOs. We assume our Client will timely supply this information and supporting documents or there will be engagement delays.

- 5. In accordance with Barbados law, each entity must register for corporate tax and VAT at the Barbados Revenue Authority.
- 6. For an active trading company, these accounting and tax fees are an estimate of Healy Consultants Group PLC fees to efficiently and effectively discharge your annual company accounting and tax obligations. Following receipt of a set of draft accounting numbers from your company, Healy Consultants Group PLC will more accurately advise accounting and tax fees. For a dormant company, Healy Consultants Group PLC fees are only US\$950.
- 7. All fees quoted in this invoice correspond to fees quoted on Healy Consultants Group PLC's website. Please review this invoice carefully to identify errors. During the rush of the business day, it is possible that Healy Consultants Group PLC inadvertently made fee calculation errors, typing errors or omitted services or omitted historic fee payments from Clients. In the unfortunate event you identify invoice errors, please revert to me directly re the same. I apologise in advance if I or my staff made invoice errors.
- 8. Assuming our Clients re-engage Healy Consultants Group PLC in year 2, this fee is an estimate of the fees payable next year, 12 months after the date of company registration.
- 9. Engage Healy Consultants Group PLC to project manage business set up in every country on the planet. We are the <u>best in the world</u> at what we do, timely completing the A to Z of every country engagement.
- 10. The fees quoted in this invoice are a prediction of the fees required to efficiently and effectively complete this engagement in a timely manner. If during the engagement Healy Consultants Group PLC realises that the project is more complex than anticipated, requiring a large additional investment of time, my Firm will revert to request additional fees.
- 11. In accordance with Barbados Company Law there is no minimum issued share capital required for Barbados LLC.
- 12. If our Client and Healy Consultants Group PLC properly plan this engagement, our Clients will <u>not</u> have to travel during this engagement. Healy Consultants Group PLC will efficiently complete representative office registration and corporate bank account opening in a timely manner without our Client's presence. Instead, our Client will need to i) sign and get documents legalised in the embassy in their country of origin and ii) courier the originals to Healy Consultants Group PLC's office.



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
- 13. Depending on our Client's business and nationality, the Barbados government may require a special regulatory licence to carry on your business in the country. Healy Consultants Group PLC will assist our Client secure licence approval. There may be additional engagement fees. However, the government enjoys ultimate power of approval of company registrations and business licenses.
- 14. If our Client requires non-resident <u>nominee shareholder and director services</u>, Healy Consultants Group PLC will be pleased to assist. Our fee for professional, passive nominee corporate shareholder amounts to US\$2,100 per annum. Our fee to be both nominee director and shareholder amounts to US\$6,600 per annum. Being the sole shareholders and sole director of a Client's company exposes Healy Consultants Group PLC to reputation, litigation and financial risk.
- 15. If required, Healy Consultants Group PLC will be pleased to assist your firm to secure employee visa approvals. Our fee is US\$2,950 for the first employee, US\$1,950 for the second employee, US\$950 per employee thereafter. Our employee visa fees includes preparation of a quality visa application and submitting to the correct Government immigration officers. The government enjoys ultimate power of approval of visa applications. Consequently, guaranteed success is outside of Healy Consultants Group PLC' control. What is inside our control is the preparation and submission of a high quality immigration visa application that maximises the likelihood of visa approval.
- 16. Some of our Clients request us to provide temporary shared office space for 6 months until their preferred business premises is found. If your Firm requires this service, our one-time fee is US\$950. Monthly rental thereafter is paid directly to the landlord, independently of Healy Consultants Group PLC.
- 17. Monthly and mid-year government tax obligations include bi-monthly VAT and mid-year corporation tax return filing. Healy Consultants Group PLC can complete monthly government reporting for a monthly fee of US\$860. Healy Consultants Group PLC monthly support will include i) receiving in Dropbox the monthly invoices from our client ii) labelling monthly bank statement transactions iii) preparing and submitting VAT returns and iv) submitting monthly employee payroll reporting.
 - In accordance with the <u>Barbados Companies Act Ch 308</u>, annual legal obligations of a Barbados company include i) filing of annual return by 31 January each year ii) filing of annual tax return by 31 June each year iii) renewal of business licence by 31 January each year and iv) annual statutory audit if annual turnover exceeds US\$2 million.
- 18. During the engagement, shareholders' and directors' documents may need to be translated into the local language, before the government and bank approves company registration and corporate bank account opening respectively. Our Client should budget for possible additional translation and embassy attestation fees. Either our Client or Healy Consultants Group PLC can complete this administrative task.
 - As always, Healy Consultants Group PLC will negotiate with all third parties to eliminate or reduce additional engagement costs. For transparency purposes, all third-party fee payments will be supported by original receipts and invoices. Examples of possible third-party payments include i) embassy fees ii) notary public costs iii) official translator fees.

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- 20. It is important our Clients are aware of their personal and corporate tax obligations in their country of residence and domicile. Let us know if you need Healy Consultants Group PLC help to clarify your local and international annual tax reporting obligations.
- 21. As stipulated on our <u>business website</u> and in section 3 of our engagement letter, Healy Consultants Group PLC will only commence the engagement following i) settlement of our fees; and ii) completion and signing of our legal engagement letter.
- 22. Healy Consultants Group PLC will only incorporate your company after 75% of <u>due diligence documentation</u> is received by email. Healy Consultants Group PLC will only open a corporate bank account after 100% of the Client's original due diligence documentation is received by courier.
- 23. During the annual renewal engagement with our Client, our in-house <u>Legal and Compliance Department</u> reviews the quality and completeness of our Client file. Consequently, Healy Consultants Group PLC may revert to our Client to ask for more up to date <u>due diligence documentation</u>.
- 24. To assist our Clients to minimise foreign exchange costs, we offer payment in SG\$, Euro, Pounds or US\$. Kindly let me know in which currency your Firm prefers to settle our fees and I will send an updated invoice, thank you.
- 25. Some of our Clients engage Healy Consultants Group PLC to <u>recruit local employees</u>. We have a lot of experience in this area and we are quite skilled at securing quality candidates for our Clients.
