Notes to invoice above

 Healy Consultants fees to efficiently and effectively complete Guatemala branch registration within <u>five weeks</u> (click link) by i) choosing the optimum regulatory license for our Client's business activities ii) reserving a branch name with the <u>Registrar of Commercial Entities</u> iii) settling our accountant and lawyer fees and iv) preparing a high quality company registration application for the <u>Registrar of Commercial Entities</u>;

All <u>engagement fees</u> (click link) are agreed and paid up front and agree to the fees published on our country web pages. Consequently, there are no hidden fees, surprises or ambushes throughout the engagement. All engagement deadlines are agreed up front in the form of a <u>detailed project plan</u>, mapping out <u>deliverables</u> by week throughout the engagement term;



Every week during the engagement, Healy Consultants will email our Client a <u>detailed status</u> <u>update</u>. Our Client is immediately informed of engagement problems together with solutions. Your dedicated engagement manager is reachable by phone, Skype, live chat and email and will communicate in your preferred language;

- 2. In accordance with <u>Guatemala Commercial Code</u> article 24, a branch shall as from the date of its registration have a legal registered office in Guatemala, to which all official government communications and notices may be addressed. To comply with this statutory requirement, Healy Consultants' Guatemala office will be the registered office address for your branch. Thereafter, this address will be used to receive government correspondence including i) tax letters ii) notice of the legal annual return; and iii) all government communications. Most of our Clients wish to place <u>Healy Consultants' office address</u> on invoices, contracts, websites and business cards;
- 3. This fee is an estimate of government costs payable during the engagement. For transparency purposes, all government fee payments will be supported by original receipts and invoices. Examples of government costs include i) reserving a branch name with the <u>Registrar of Commercial Entities</u> ii) preparing a high quality branch registration application for the <u>Registrar of Commercial Entities</u> iii) issuance of the commercial license fees iv) Social Security Number issuance fees and authorization for accounting books and v) publication of the notice of registration in the Central American Gazette.

Following engagement completion, Healy Consultants will refund our Client any excess of funds received over actual Government costs paid;

4. Healy Consultants will be pleased to open a Guatemala corporate bank account without our Client travel. It is a time consuming task, and Healy Consultants will shelter our Client from the associated administrative challenges. As you can appreciate, it is a difficult task to obtain bank account approval through a newly formed branch when the parent company, directors and bank signatories reside overseas. Healy Consultants will prepare a business plan for the bank to optimize the probability of corporate bank account approval. Depending on our Client's business and nationality, there is a 20% probability the banks will request a bank signatory to travel for a one hour bank interview. Healy Consultants will try its best to negotiate with the bank for a travel exemption. If our Client must travel to Guatemala for corporate bank account opening, Healy Consultants will refund our Client US\$950;

If our Client is not comfortable with only a Guatemala corporate bank account, Healy Consultants will be pleased to open an additional international corporate bank account (click link) outside of Guatemala. Examples include New York, Germany, Liechtenstein, Austria, Bulgaria, South Africa, Australia, London, South America or Dubai. All banks will be top tier banks in these countries with excellent internet banking services. Example of our global banking partners include HSBC, Standard Chartered Bank, Citibank, Barclays, Standard bank, ANZ bank, VTB bank, UBS and Credit Suisse;

The banks enjoys ultimate power of approval of corporate bank account applications. Consequently, guaranteed success is outside of Healy Consultants' control. What is inside our control is the preparation and submission of a high quality bank application that maximizes the likelihood of approval. To date, we enjoy a 100% approval record because of <u>our global banking relationships</u> and determination.







Global banks continue to tighten corporate bank account opening procedures, their internal compliance departments completing more thorough due diligence of Clients. Consequently, our Clients should expect the bank account approval period to take up to 4 weeks. Furthermore, global banks now require evidence of proof of business in the country where the corporate bank account will be, including sales contracts or lease agreement;

 In accordance with the <u>Guatemala Commercial Code</u>, each entity must register for corporate tax, VAT and social security registraion at the at the <u>Guatemala tax administration</u> and the <u>Social Security Authority</u>;

6. For an active trading branch, these <u>accounting and tax</u> fees are an estimate of Healy Consultants fees to effectively discharge your annual branch accounting and tax obligations. Following receipt of a set of draft accounting numbers from your branch, Healy Consultants will more accurately advise accounting and tax fees. For a dormant branch, Healy Consultants fees are only US\$950;



- 7. All fees quoted in this invoice correspond to fees quoted on Healy Consultants' website. Please review this invoice carefully to identify errors. During the rush of the business day, it is possible that Healy Consultants inadvertently made fee calculation errors, typing errors or omitted services or omitted historic fee payments from Clients. In the unfortunate event you identify invoice errors, please revert to me directly re the same. I apologize in advance if I or my staff made invoice errors;
- 8. Assuming our Clients re-engage Healy Consultants in year 2, this fee is an estimate of the fees payable next year, 12 months after the date of branch registration;
- 9. The fees quoted in this invoice are a prediction of the fees required to efficiently and effectively complete this engagement in a timely manner. If during the engagement Healy Consultants realizes that the project is more complex than anticipated, requiring a large additional investment of time, my Firm will revert to request additional fees. If Healy Consultants completes the engagement faster and more easily than expected, Healy Consultants is happy to refund some fees to our Client:
- 10. Branch business activities are limited to that of the parent company. The branch suffers a corporation tax of 25%. A branch can i) lease office premises and ii) issue sales invoice to Clients' and iii) sign local legal contracts. A branch can import and export goods. The life of the branch is limited to that of the parent company;
- 11. Engage Healy Consultants to <u>project manage</u> business set up in every country on the planet. We are the best in the <u>world</u> at what we do, timely completing <u>the A to Z</u> of every country engagement;
- 12. In accordance with the <u>Guatemala Commercial Code</u>, the issued guarantee of US\$50,000 must be deposited to the branch bank account prior to branch registration. To optimize engagement efficiency and minimize delays, Healy Consultants is happy to deposit these funds on behalf of our clients;
- 13. Some of our Clients' engage Healy Consultants to <u>recruit (click link)</u> local employees. We have a lot of experience in this area and we are quite skilled at securing quality candidates for our Clients';

- 14. In accordance with the Guatemala Commercial Code, each Guatemala branch must have i) one individual director or ii) one legal representative (locally known as the trade auxiliary) ordinarily resident in Guatemala. If required, Healy Consultants will be pleased to provide your firm with a professional nominee legal representative in Guatemala. Our fee amounts to US\$6,600 per annum;
- 15.If our Client and Healy Consultants properly plan this engagement, our Clients' will <u>not</u> have to travel during this engagement. Healy Consultants will efficiently complete branch registration and corporate bank account opening in a timely manner without our Client presence. Instead, our Client will need to i) sign and get documents legalized in the embassy in their country of origin and ii) courier the originals to Healy Consultants office;



- 16. Depending on our Client's business and nationality, the Guatemala Government may require a special regulatory license to carry on your business in the country. Healy Consultants will assist our Client secure license approval. There may be additional engagement fees. However, the Government enjoys ultimate power of approval of branch registrations and business licenses;
- 17. If our Client requires non-resident nominee shareholder and director <u>services (click link)</u>, Healy Consultants will be pleased to assist. Our fee for professional, passive nominee non-resident corporate shareholder amounts to US\$2,100 per annum. Our fee to be both non-resident nominee director and shareholder amounts to US\$6,600 per annum. Being the sole shareholders and sole director of a Client's branch exposes Healy Consultants to reputation, litigation and financial risk;
- 18. If required, Healy Consultants will be pleased to assist your firm to secure employee visa approvals. Our fee is US\$2,950 for the first employee, US\$1,950 for the second employee, US\$950 per employee thereafter. Our employee visa fees includes preparation of a quality visa application and submitting to the correct Government immigration officers. The Government enjoys ultimate power of approval of visa applications. Consequently, guaranteed success is outside of Healy Consultants' control. What is inside our control is the preparation and submission of a high quality immigration visa application that maximizes the likelihood of visa approval;
- 19. Some of our Clients request Healy Consultants to provide temporary shared office space for 6 months until their preferred business premises is found. If your Firm requires this service, our one-time fee is US\$950. Monthly rental thereafter is paid directly to the landlord, independently of Healy Consultants;

- 20. It is important our Clients are aware of their personal and corporate tax obligations in their country of residence and domicile. Let us know if you need Healy Consultants help to clarify your local and international annual tax reporting obligations;
- 21. Monthly, quarterly and mid-year Government tax obligations include i) monthly payroll reporting and social security contributions to the <u>Guatemala Social Security Authority</u> ii) advance quarterly corporate income tax payments and iii) monthly or quarterly VAT returns filing to the <u>Guatemala Tax Authority</u>. If you need our help, Healy Consultants can complete monthly Government reporting for a monthly fee of US\$860. Healy Consultants' monthly support will include i) receive in dropbox the monthly invoices from our client ii) label monthly bank statement transactions iii) preparation and submission of VAT returns and iv) submission of monthly employee payroll reporting;
- 22. Some of our Clients' require an <u>immediate Guatemala solution</u>. With this strategy, within a day Healy Consultants can supply our Client i) an existing dormant Guatemala company number and ii) an already approved Guatemala corporate bank account number and iii) a business address. Turnkey solutions are attractive to those entrepreneurs who wish to immediately close a country deal, sign a contract or invoice a customer;
- 23. During the engagement, the parent company's and directors' documents may need to be translated into Spanish before the Government and Bank approves branch registration and corporate bank account opening respectively. Consequently, our Client should budget for possible additional translation and embassy attestation fees. Either our Client or Healy Consultants can complete this administrative task;
 - As always, Healy Consultants will negotiate with all third parties to eliminate or reduce additional engagement costs. For transparency purposes, all third party fee payments will be supported by original receipts and invoices. Examples of possible third party payments include i) embassy fees ii) notary public costs iii) official translator fees;
- 24. As stipulated on our <u>business website</u> and in section 3 of our engagement letter, Healy Consultants will only commence the engagement following i) settlement of our fees and ii) completion and signing of our legal engagement letter;
- 25. Healy Consultants will only register your branch after 75% of <u>due diligence documentation</u> is received by email. Healy Consultants will only open a corporate bank account after 100% of the Client's original due diligence documentation is received by courier;
- 26. During the annual renewal engagement with our Client, our in-house <u>Legal and Compliance</u> <u>Department (click link)</u> reviews the quality and completeness of our Client file.
